Andechs Dunkel Export	5.2%	“A smooth, creamy dark beer; nutty with roast malt and coffee flavours.”
Andechs Doppelbok Dunkel	7%	“Toffee & toasted biscuit + chocolate vanilla. Sienna dark, sweet & complex.” £5.20
Andechs Helles Weissbier	5.5%	“A smooth, fruity and aromatic wheat beer, with a flavour of banana and cloves.”
